

Privacy Policy for Suppliers

Aeronautics Ltd.

1. Introduction and Scope

This Privacy Policy is intended to explain how **Aeronautics Ltd.** (the "**Company**" or "**we**"), acting as the Controller of the database, collects, uses, and shares information regarding suppliers, supplier representatives, subcontractors, and other service providers (a "**Supplier**" or "**Suppliers**") with whom it has engaged, as well as to clarify their rights under applicable law. This Privacy Policy forms an integral part of the agreement signed between the Company and the Supplier (the "**Agreement**"), to the extent such an agreement has been signed.

2. Collection of Information

The details collected or provided by the Supplier during the engagement process and the ongoing relationship are stored in our database in accordance with legal requirements and as specified in this Privacy Policy:

- 2.1. **Voluntary Disclosure:** Personal information is provided with the Supplier's consent. While there is no legal obligation to provide it (unless specified in the Agreement or by law), a refusal to provide necessary information may affect our ability to evaluate the engagement.
- 2.2. **Third-Party Sources:** Information may be received directly from the Supplier or via third parties such as performance analysis entities, accounting firms, consultants, and representatives.
- 2.3. **Public Information:** Information published in the media and on social networks may also be collected.
- 2.4. **Third-Party Data:** If the Supplier provides information regarding third parties, the Supplier declares that it has obtained their consent for the transfer, storage, and processing of such information.

3. Categories of Personal Information Collected

During the engagement and throughout the term of the Agreement, the Company may collect and process the following categories of "**Personal Information**":

- 3.1. **Supplier Details:** Business name, VAT/Authorized Dealer number, address, bank account details, and contact information.
- 3.2. **Representative Details:** Names, email addresses, telephone numbers, residential addresses, ID numbers, dates of birth, job titles, supervisors, professional certifications, and confidentiality undertakings of employees or representatives of the Supplier.
- 3.3. **Engagement Records:** Correspondence, quotes, agreements, performance reports, meeting minutes, audits, and compliance questionnaires (including security and privacy data).
- 3.4. **Legal & Due Diligence:** Any additional information required by law or collected during periodic audits and due diligence.

4. **Purposes of Processing**

We use Personal Information for the following purposes:

- 4.1. **Contractual Management:** Managing the engagement, payments, performance monitoring, and oversight.
- 4.2. **Legal Compliance:** Complying with tax laws, labor laws, privacy regulations, and internal or regulatory security procedures.
- 4.3. **Risk Management:** Internal audits, security incident management, documentation, and legal defense.
- 4.4. **Ongoing Communication:** Coordinating with supplier representatives and providing professional updates.

5. **Sharing and Transfer of Information**

The Company may transfer Personal Information to third parties for the aforementioned purposes, including to entities in other countries (including the USA):

- 5.1. Business partners, subsidiaries, or affiliated companies.
- 5.2. In the event of a merger, acquisition, or potential sale transaction.
- 5.3. Service providers assisting in daily operations, such as supplier management systems or accounting firms.
- 5.4. As required by law, court order, or a competent authority, or for legal defense.

6. **Use of Artificial Intelligence (AI)**

- 6.1. We may use AI tools to process your Personal Information, including for analysis, classification, and generating predictions or recommendations.
- 6.2. These systems use algorithms to identify patterns and generate automated insights from historical data.
- 6.3. Potential risks include algorithmic bias, processing errors, automated decision-making, and data security risks associated with large-scale processing.
- 6.4. While we implement reasonable security measures and strive for transparency, we cannot guarantee that errors or inaccuracies will not occur.

7. **Data Subject Rights**

Suppliers have certain rights regarding their Personal Information:

- 7.1. **Right of Access:** The right to request access to the personal information being processed, subject to other balancing interests.
- 7.2. **Right to Rectification and Erasure:** The right to request the correction of inaccurate, outdated, or incomplete information.
